Launching the competitive entrance examination into the first year of the engineering training program at the National Advanced School of Maritime and ocean Science and Technology (NASMOST) of the University of Ebolowa, and defining the number of places opened for the 2024/2025.

THE MINISTER OF STATE, MINISTER OF HIGHER EDUCATION:

Mindful of the Constitution; of Law n°2023/007 of 25th July 2023 on Higher Education Policy in Cameroon; Mindful of Decree N°2011/408 of 09th December 2011 organising the Government; Mindful of Decree N°93/026 of 19th January 1993 to create Universities; Mindful of Decree N°2005/142of 29th April 2005 organising the Ministry of Higher Education Mindful of Decree N°2005/342 of 10thSeptember 2005 modifying and completing certain Mindful disposition of decree N°93/027 of 19 January 1993 fixing common dispositions in Universities: of Decree N°2009/008 of 12th January 2009 appointing authorities in State Universities: Mindful of Decree N°2011/408 of 09th December 2011 organizing the government: Mindful of Decree N°2011/410 of 09th December training the government; Mindful of Decree N°2012/433 of 01October 2012 organizing the Ministry of Higher Education; Mindful of Decree N°2013/0891/PM of 01march 2013 appointing authorities in the Ministry of Mindful Higher Education; of Decree N°2018/190 of 02 March 2018 completing certain dispositions of DecreeN°2011/408 Mindful Of 09th December organizing the government; of Decree N°2019/002 of 04 January 2019 reshuffling the Government; Mindful of Decree N°2022/003 of 05th January 2022 creating universities; Mindful of Decree N°2022/009 of 06th January 2022 laying down the administrative and academic Mindful Organization of the University of Ebolowa: of Decree N°2022/239 of 17th June 2022 appointing authorities in certain State Universities; Mindful of Decree N°2023/302 of 04th July 2023 appointing authorities in certain State Universities; Mindful Mindful of Decision N° 18240028 of 14th February 2024 setting up the calendar for competitive entrance Examinations into Cameroon State Universities and Schools under the Academic Tutelage of The Ministry of Higher Education for the 2024/2025 academic year;

DECIDES:

Article 1:

(1) A written competitive entrance examination for the recruitment of Five hundred (500) students into the first year Common Core courses in the Maritime and Oceanographic Sciences and Technology (MOST) and in the Sciences of Maritime and Port Management (SMPM) specialties at the National Advanced School of Maritime and Ocean Science and Technology (NASMOST) of the University of Ebolowa, for the 2024/2025 academic year is organized in the following centers: Kribi, Douala, Ebolowa, Bafoussam, Bertoua, Buea, Garoua and Yaoundé.

(2) The table below specifies the required certificates to be qualified for the entrance examination according

to the areas:

Article 2:

- (1) That syllabus level for the written examination is that of student from Lower and UP Sixth science subjects and for the *Première and Terminale* classes of the afore mentioned candidates.
- (2) No oral examination is needed.

Article 3:

- (1) Successful Civil servants or workers shall contribute the training costs, with the specific amount determined by a specific text.
- (2) International candidates who are endorsed by their Government for this training programm will be accepted under the same academic requirements as mentioned earlier, based on the availability of spots.

Article 4: Candidates registered with awaiting certificates (certificates mentioned above) shall only be definitively admitted to NASMOST, in the event of success in the entrance examination, upon presentation of the original of the certificate obtained at the 2023 examination session or; where applicable of the attestation of success at the time of registration defined by NASMOST.

Article 5: The applicable files shall comprise the following documents:

- 1. An application form to be filled online at the website http://www.enstmo-ueb.cm downloaded and stamped at 1500 CFA francs by the candidate;
- 2. A certificate true copy of the national identity card;
- 3. A certificate true copy of the birth certificate dated not more than three (03) months;
- 4. A certificate true copy of the GCE/OL or Probatoire and GCE/AL or Baccalaureate transcripts dated not more than three (03) months; as the case may be;
- 5. A certificate true copy of the GCE/AL or Baccalaureate certificates in sciences subject dated not more than three (03) months; or thee equivalent diploma or a certificate of success of one of these diplomas, if applicable;
- 6. A medical certificate dated not more than three (03) months issued by a public medical practitioner;
- 7. An envelope bearing a CFA 1500 FCFA stamp and the candidate's address;
- 8. Four (4) passport-size photographs bearing the candidate's names and surnames at the back;
- 9. A receipt of twenty thousand (20000) FCFA as examination fee issued by SCB Bank Cameroon account N°90001487730 should be joined to the candidate's file. These no-refundable fees are intended to cover the expenses generated by the organization of the competitive examination. Another method of payment is excluded.

Article 6: Holders of foreign certificates shall submit either the equivalence or the receipt showing that they applied for the equivalent delivered by the Ministry of higher Education. The final admission of these candidates shall be confirmed only upon presentation, within the deadline set by the competent authorities of the order granting equivalence issued by the Minister of Higher Education.

Article 7: Complete application files must be submitted on Thursday September 12, 2024 at 3. 30 p.m.to the Education and Statistics Unit of the National Advanced School of Maritime and Ocean Science and Technology (NASMOST) of the University of Ebolowa in Kribi, as well as the regional delegations of the Ministry of Secondary Education.

Article 8: Only Candidates who have a complete regulatory file will be allowed to participate in the exams. They must also bring their national identity cards and the entrance examination registration receipt (to be downloaded) as these will be necessary.

Article 9: Candidates for the first-year entrance examination must be twenty-nine (29) years old at most, on January 1, 2024, the year of the examination.

Article 10: The entrance examination will take place on Sunday, September 15, 2024 from 8 a.m. at the centers mentioned above.

Article 11:

- (1) The competitive entrance examination includes:
 - Two (02) written papers accounting for 75%;
 - School marks counting for 25%.
- (2) This school mark will be determined based on the candidate's age, his academic performance and the number of year spent to obtain the required degree.

Article 12: The written papers are scheduled per specialties as follows:

Article 13 The Rector of the University of Ebolowa, the Director of University Accreditations and quality and the Director of the National Advanced School of Maritime and Ocean Science and Technology (NASMOST) are responsible, each in his respective capacity, for the implementation of this Decision which shall be registered and published in English and French wherever necessary.
